Therefore let us Proclaim to the World that we will call upon the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. We humble ourselves and repent for our transgressions. We humbly seek His forgiveness for our many sins and disobediences.

Now, therefore, I, James Buchanan Geiger, President of the Republic for the United States of America, do hereby appoint and set apart July 2nd, 2016 to be a day of prayer, humiliation, and repentance for these many sins of the Nation and ourselves.

Let it also be Proclaimed that July 3rd, 2016 shall be a day of prayer and fasting for the deliverance of the Nation from the tyrant of the Nations of the world and all creation.

Furthermore it is hereby Proclaimed that July 4th, 2016 is a day of celebration, feasting and remembrance. Let us celebrate the Liberties that our Sovereign God has granted us. Let us celebrate, in

feasting, the bountiful blessings He has bestowed on this covenant land. Let us, each man and woman, read ourselves and to our children the *Declaration of Independence*, our covenant with the Divine Creator. Let us celebrate in remembrance of His faithful hand of Providence to establish this Nation by delivering and defending our fathers. And let us celebrate in expectation of His favor upon this people and this Nation. And let us be resolute to Our God and ourselves to forever hand down to our children His-story and our heritage to be a Nation and a people unto Him.

And Finally let us Proclaim⁴ to all of creation and to every prince, throne, dominion and spirit in Heaven and on earth that the God of this Nation is now and forever shall be the Great Creator, Natures God and the Divine Judge of the world.
